# SOCIAL MEDIA AND DIGITAL MARKETING ROLE

# **VOLUNTEER RESPONSIBILITIES**

The role will vary depending on needs, but is likely to include:

- Putting together a monthly social media plan
- Posting against that plan, including setting up and promoting events on Facebook, creating content and sharing relevant posts
- Checking for posts that tag the Railway Land or use relevant hashtags
- · Joining conversations in Lewes and in the environmental / conservation community to help get the Railway Land Wildlife Trust "seen" digitally
- Taking photographs of the reserve or events for posting
- Uploading information about events to other relevant websites
- With support, analysing the digital activity to help us target our communications effectively
